**Language-** Days of the week and recognition of letters.

**Math-**Study of diamond, triangle and counting numbers.

**Science-**Animal habitats, recognizing vegetables, and learning plant parts.

**Practical Life-** Putting on winter clothes.

**Preschool Rooms**

**Math** – Bigger and smaller number concepts and concept of whole and half.

**Language** – Story telling, writing the letter of the week, and phonics sounds

**Practical Life** – Putting on clothing and bathroom manners
